Most of us, at some time, come into contact with local health and social care services – from an occasional visit to a GP, to a long-term programme of care and support.

Chances are, there are things about those services you like – and things you want to see improved. Now there's a new way to make sure that your views are heard.

Sheffield LINK (Local Involvement Network) gives everyone who uses health and social care services in our city the chance to influence them – the way they are planned, and the way they are delivered.



Part of an initiative set up by the Department of Health but completely independent of it, Sheffield LINK has powers that help it make a difference. Led by its members, Sheffield LINK:

- asks local people what they think of health and social care services in the city
- makes sure these views are heard by the people who plan and run these services
- investigates issues that concern local people
- visits facilities and checks that services are working well.

Anyone living in Sheffield, or travelling into the city to use health and social care services, can join Sheffield LINK and it's completely free.
