



# Burngreave Ward Health Profile 2009



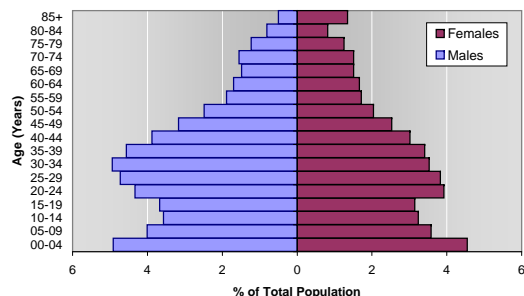

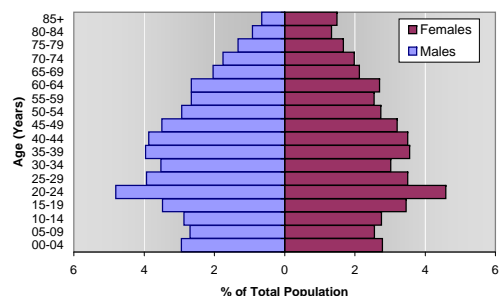

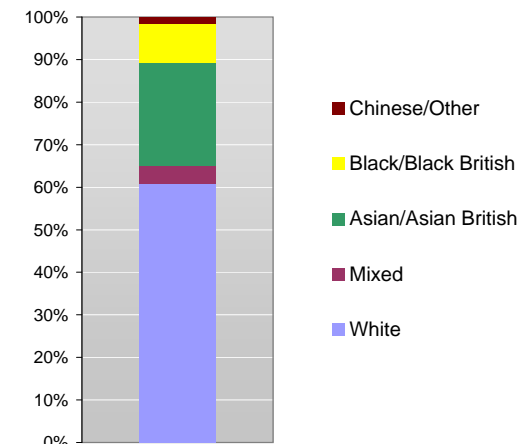
